# The month of March is traditionally dedicated to the St Joseph.

As we continue our journey "up to Jerusalem" during the month of March, three prominent ideas are proposed for our contemplation by the liturgy of Lent: the Passion and Resurrection of Christ, baptism, and penance.

The Solemnity of St. Joseph (March 19) is a special landmark this month in which we will celebrate the great honor bestowed upon the foster father of Jesus.

The entire month of March, except the very last day, falls during the liturgical season of Lent which is represented by the liturgical color violet or purple — a symbol of penance, mortification and the sorrow of a contrite heart. All saint days that are usually Memorials are shifted to Optional Memorials during the season of Lent. The last day of the month is the beginning of the Easter season.

# Easter Season 2024

Easter Sunday falls on Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. It is a significant day for Catholics and other Christians as it commemorates the resurrection of Jesus Christ. During this season, believers celebrate the victory of life over death and the hope of salvation.

Some key traditions and practices associated with Catholic Easter:

- Palm Sunday marks both the end of Lent and the beginning of Holy Week. It commemorates Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. Parishioners receive blessed palm leaves during Mass, which can be made into crosses or kept as personal devotions.
- On Holy Thursday, Catholics commemorate the Last Supper of Jesus and the institution of the priesthood. This meal, celebrated as a Passover feast, emphasizes unity, service, and the Eucharist.

  and culminates in the joyous proclamation of Christ's resurrection. New converts are traditionally baptized, confirmed, and
  receive their first Holy Communion during this vigil.
- Easter Sunday is the pinnacle of the Christian calendar. It symbolizes the fulfillment of faith through Christ's resurrection. Catholics attend Mass, celebrating the victory of life over death.
- Easter extends beyond a single day—it encompasses the entire Easter season, leading up to Pentecost Sunday and celebrating the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. May this Easter bring you blessings and renewed hope!
